ICT1 - Technology tools for Educators

SE1-Children with Learning Difficulties

Teachers are often responsible for a classroom of children with many individual and cultural differences, as well as several behavioral problems. Teachers can play an important role in helping them manage their problems and diagnose the early signs of the learning difficulties. This course will prepare you for identifying the signs of learning difficulties and will provide you with tools to diagnose and deal with such problems in class.

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HE1-Conflict Resolution

Students are frequently and constantly in conflict with each other on varying levels. Teachers called upon to intervene. This course explores conflict resolution and the varying stages with practical advice on how it can be applied in schools.

HE2-Sexuality Awareness

In Europe it is commonly held that 1 in 5 young people will have been victims of sexual abuse, while at the same time the school curriculum includes issues of relationships and sexual awareness. Teachers are required to teach young people about a subject that is both culturally and socially sensitive while being a natural part of everyday life. This course explores how to approach the subject of sexuality, sexual orientation, sexual abuse and cultural diversity.

HE3-Sexual Awareness and Disability

While it is widely accepted that one in five of young people up to the age of eighteen with have been sexually abused, the number is unknown amongst young people the physical and/or mental disabilities. Many suspect it is higher due to the personal space access of carers and others, combined with the persons' inability to speak out. This course demonstrates ways to empower. The course material is based on the work of the Cyprus Family Planning Association.

HE4-Intervention Analysis

Based on the work of John Heron, intervention analysis takes a look at the impact of our interventions. The course explores the six categories of prescriptive, cathartic, informative, catalytic, supportive and confrontational, from various perspectives. Appropriate and inappropriate use, as well as practice in using the interventions in combination to enhance a layer of classroom teaching which is often overlooked—communication .
